

## **Parent Responsibilities, Attitude and Cooperation**

The enrollment of a child/ren at Mother of Sorrows School means cooperation with efforts and objectives set by school personnel. **Enrollment at the school is an agreement to read and sign the parent/student handbook, and to support the parish school's philosophy, policies and programs.**

The parish school and parents need to work together for the education of the child. **If a student is to benefit from the educational program at Mother of Sorrows School, parental attitude must be positive and supportive.** Parental disruption of the educational, philosophical or Christian atmosphere of the parish school is indicative of the need to seek another educational institution, which satisfies parental expectations.

Mother of Sorrows School faculty, staff and administration look forward to a strong, positive partnership with parents. Together this team of adults can have a significant impact on the development of the children who attend Mother of Sorrows School.

- Be an active participating member of Mother of Sorrows parish or in your own community.
- Volunteer your stewardship to the parish and to the school.
- **Be convinced that the education at Mother of Sorrows School is the best for your child and let your child know this.**
- Communicate a positive attitude of support and encouragement to your child regarding both her own work and development, and the intentions of the school personnel and programs.
- Have the desire that your child learns as much as he is capable.
- **Accept the outlined standards for the behavior of your child while she is in school.**
- Discuss the child's problems with the teacher and principal in light of trying to find solutions rather than finding fault.
- Provide the atmosphere and encouragement for the effective use of time spent on homework.
- Visit the school to learn what is being done for your child.
- **Communicate your concerns in a Christ-like attitude that shows respect for others.**
