

# Third Grade School Supply List 2010-2011

The following is a list of supplies your child will need to bring on or before the first day of school.



**Please make sure all items are labeled with the student's name.**

- 1 pair of Scissors (Fiskars are the best!)
- Crayons (24 count maximum)
- Colored pencils
- Washable markers (either size)
- 1 permanent Sharpie marker
- 3 ball-point style pens (black or blue)
- 10 Glue sticks (these run out quick – you may want to stock up on extras now!)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's School Glue
- 3 good erasers (like Pink Pearl Erasers)
- 10 SHARPENED Pencils
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener
- Zippered or bag style pencil pouch that will fit all of your basic supplies (two small ones would work as well)  
*I strongly recommend that students use a soft pencil case to prevent breakage if they are dropped!*
- Four Square-sized (about 3x3) Sticky Note Tablets
- One larger sized (about 4x6) Sticky Note Tablet
- 3 composition style notebooks (these are the 'marble' like ones) Any colors - different colors or designs would be helpful if you can find them
- 3 regular single subject notebooks (wide-ruled is best) in the following colors: Blue, Red, and Purple (or Black)
- 10 two pocket folders (Plastic style works best as these hold up the longest): In the following colors: Blue, Red, Purple (or Black), Green, Yellow, and 4 in any color or design you choose
- 1 pocket folder with prongs in any color or style you choose
- Cereal Box bottom (Please cut the box so it stands approx. 5 inches high) Box may be covered and decorated if desired – this will be used for storing extra supplies in our lockers
