### PANDEMIC SAFEGUARDS

- A PANDEMIC (COVID-19) PARENT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT MUST BE SIGNED TO ATTEND MOSS.
- ALL COMMUNICATIONS REGARDING FAMILY PANDEMIC SITUATIONS MUST BE COMMUNICATED WITH THE PRINCIPAL, NOT THE TEACHER.

<b>TRANSPORTATION:</b>	A face covering is mandatory on all buses until further notice.
<b>FACE COVERING:</b>	A face covering is recommended, but not mandatory, while in the school building.
<b>CLASSROOMS:</b>	Classroom desks are spaced 3-6 ft. All rooms have fresh airflow. Students will move to different rooms for instruction.
<b>RESTROOM/ WATER FOUNTAIN:</b>	All students use hand sanitizer before entering the restroom. All classrooms are equipped with touchless hand sanitizer. Opportunities for handwashing are offered throughout the day. Water bottle filling stations are available on each level. All staff/students must provide their own labeled water bottle.
<b>TECHNOLOGY:</b>	All students receive a technology device.
<b>LUNCH:</b>	Students eat in the cafeteria. The cafeteria tables have dividers installed.
<b>RECESS/WALKS:</b>	Students take walks around the grounds several times each day. All students have recess sometime during the day. Each homeroom has its own playground equipment.
<b>SCHOOL CLEANING:</b>	A professional cleaning company cleans and disinfects the school each day. UVC lights are used on an alternate schedule.
<b>TRAVEL:</b>	There are no travel restrictions in place currently.

**SPORTS:** All sports will follow CDC recommendations.  
A Pandemic Sports Parent Acknowledgement must be signed for a student to participate in sports at MOSS.

**CLUBS:** Participants are in a mixed population.

**BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL:** Participants are in a mixed population.

**DISTANCE LEARNING:** Distance learning is available to students who must be excluded from school due to pandemic protocols or for students who are waiting for test results.

Students receive their instruction through the Schoology learning platform virtually at home. The instruction is synchronous with the in-person classroom instruction.

**Expectations for Students/Families while distance learning:**

- Students must be in Schoology for homeroom and each class period.
- Students will find course content, resources, and assignments within each Schoology course. Students will use print textbooks/workbooks in conjunction with extra resources.
- Students must log in to Schoology by 8:30 am.
- Students must be present for morning prayer and announcements.
- Students must wear their school uniform.
- Students should be prepared to **remain on video and audio for each class period**; however, students must follow classroom rules regarding using video and audio throughout the class period.
- **Students will have access to their courses through Schoology and must submit all assignments by the assigned due date.**
- Students are expected to ask questions as if they were in person. Each teacher will clarify this.
- Recording of instruction by any means is **NOT** permitted.
