

Transitional Kindergarten Supply List

Student Supplies

- 2 JUMBO washable glue sticks (purple)
- Fiskar safety scissors – labeled with student’s name (use Sharpie)
- 2 8-pack boxes of regular (NOT Jumbo-sized) Crayola classic color crayons (red, blue, yellow, etc.)
- 2 24-count count box of Crayola crayons (not 48-count or 96-count please.)

I put 2 boxes of crayons on the list because we will not be sharing supplies this year,. This way we will be able to open a new box in January when the first box of crayons has lots of broken pieces. Because supplies are so much cheaper in the summer, I thought it made sense to put two boxes on the list at the beginning of the year.

- 1 box WASHABLE Crayola markers
- 1 pair “over the ear” headphones. “5 Below” has them for \$5.00. (Each child will use his/her own headphones in computer this year. We will not be sharing headphones.)
- Paint shirt – an old, long-sleeved t-shirt is good. It should be 2-3 sizes too big (not an adult-size t-shirt) and labeled with child’s name inside the collar.

Classroom Supplies

- 1 ream white copy paper
- 1 standard package (500) of napkins – cheap is fine.

Your child will also need:

- A backpack (mark child’s name on outside) that is large enough to hold a 9” x 12” folder, large art paper, and a lunch box.
- A seasonal change of clothes (including socks and underwear) in a Ziploc bag, labeled with the child’s name, to be kept in the student’s locker. If your child attends the “After School Program” they will keep their change of clothes in their backpack.
