What's New

7th Grade Science

In Mrs. Bentley's science class, students researched how man-made objects change over time in both structure and function. They explored various examples, such as the evolution of technology, machinery and everyday tools, analyzing how advancements affect these items. After gathering their research, the students collaborated in lab groups to create detailed timeline posters, illustrating the progression of these objects through different eras. These posters highlighted key changes in design, materials, and functionality, helping students visualize the impact of innovation and time on the tools and devices we rely on today.

8th Grade ELA

Our 8th grade students have embarked on a meaningful journey into their family histories by writing biographies of a relative, often a grandparent. Through multiple interviews and a carefully crafted collection of questions, students have gathered personal stories, childhood memories, and life experiences. 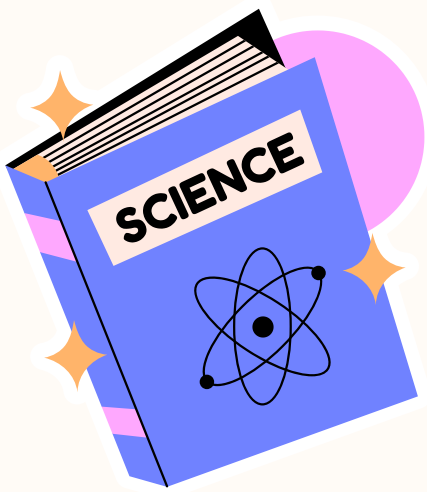
